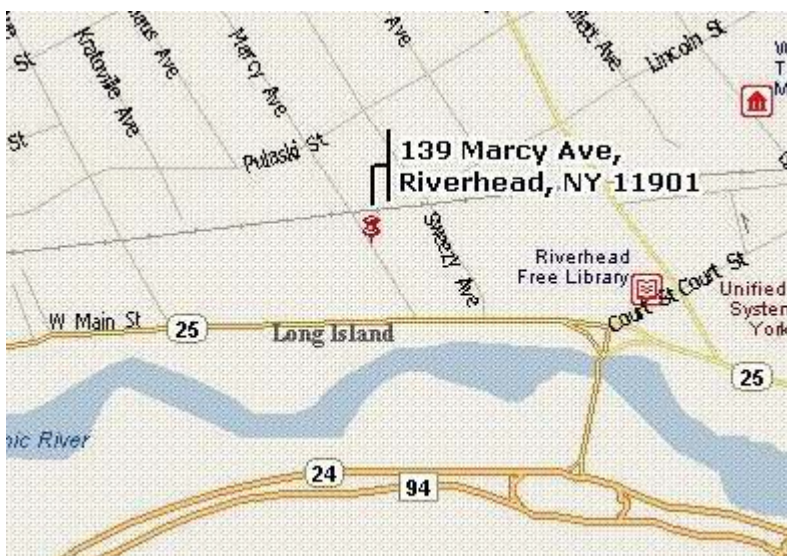
### DIRECTIONS: From the South fork
