





Planting Asparagus Crowns

Most people will turn to planting asparagus crowns when considering how to make an asparagus bed. Planting crowns will establish your asparagus bed faster so that you can harvest the asparagus sooner.

When the asparagus arrives, it will be dry looking. Soak it in tepid water for two to three hours before you're ready to plant. Asparagus planting instructions recommend that you plant the crowns 8 to 12 inces apart. Cover with about 2 inches of soil. Water the bed well after planting asparagus crowns. Be sure to provide sufficient water until the crowns show sprouts.


